Title:	Lednice - Riding hall
Description:	In years 1688 as late as 1696 a monumental complex of a three-winged stable with riding-halls was established according to the project of J. B. Fischer of Erlach and finished by Domenico Martinelli west of the chateau. Nowadays it is the oldest part of the chateau. The trio of passages with columned portals energized by allegorical statues from 1700 - 1701 by Austrian sculptor Giovanni Giuliani takes you from the courtyard.
